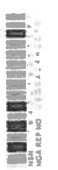
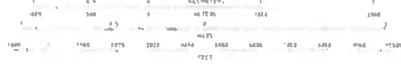
BACHELOR MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE

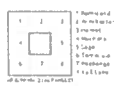
