

Drip Conversion Kit Program Guidelines

1. The Drip Conversion Kit Program is open to Rancho California Water District (RCWD) residential customers only. The installation address must be in RCWD's service area.
2. Participants in this program must agree to allow RCWD to verify that a minimum of 250 square feet are to be converted from spray to drip irrigation.
3. The spray to drip conversion project must be completed within 60 days of the receipt of the kit.
4. Participants must allow RCWD to verify (through either a photo emailed to reedyn@ranchowater.com or a site visit) that the kit has been installed. If RCWD is unable to verify that the drip system has been installed, a \$125 charge will be added to the participant's water bill.
5. Installation costs of the drip conversion kit are the sole responsibility of the program participant.
6. Limit one retrofit kit per address.

RCWD does not warrant, endorse, or assume liability for the quality, performance, or safety of the drip conversion kit.

RCWD makes no representation or warranty relating to contracted services or products that may be installed, including any hazardous substances that may be contained in any product. Installation of a drip conversion kit does not guarantee reduced water use.

By participating in this program, the customer waives, and releases RCWD and its contractors and agents from any and all claims and causes of action arising out of installation or use of devices in connection with this Drip Conversion Kit Program. Any claim the program participant (Participant) may have based upon any defect or failure of performance of a contracted service or device purchased by the applicant should be pursued with the contractor or manufacturer/distributor.

The Participant agrees to hold harmless RCWD, its directors, officers, and employees against loss, damage, expense, and liability resulting from the loss, destruction or damage to property arising out of or in any way connected with the drip conversion kit or its installation.

RCWD only enforces the terms and conditions of the Drip Conversion Kit Program. The Participant is responsible for meeting all program requirements and for checking with state/county/city governments and common interest development (associations), if any, in the area regarding local conditions, restrictions, codes, ordinances, rules, and regulations prior to purchase and/or installation.
