The fenced site is located south of Vail Ranch Parkway, approximately 300 feet east of the intersection of Vail Ranch Parkway and Redhawk Parkway. The site is located within the Pechanga 7½' quadrangle map (attached).

Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	The project includes the removal of the existing below-ground reclaimed water pump station and construction of an above-ground replacement reclaimed water pump station, including a 14-foot high block building with tile roof to house the replacement facilities. The pump station will be located within the same fenced area on the same parcel as the existing facilities. In addition to having reached the end of its useful life, the existing pump station is located in a below-ground vault, requiring hazardous confined space entry requirements. The beneficiaries of this project are the recycled water users within Rancho California Water District's service area.

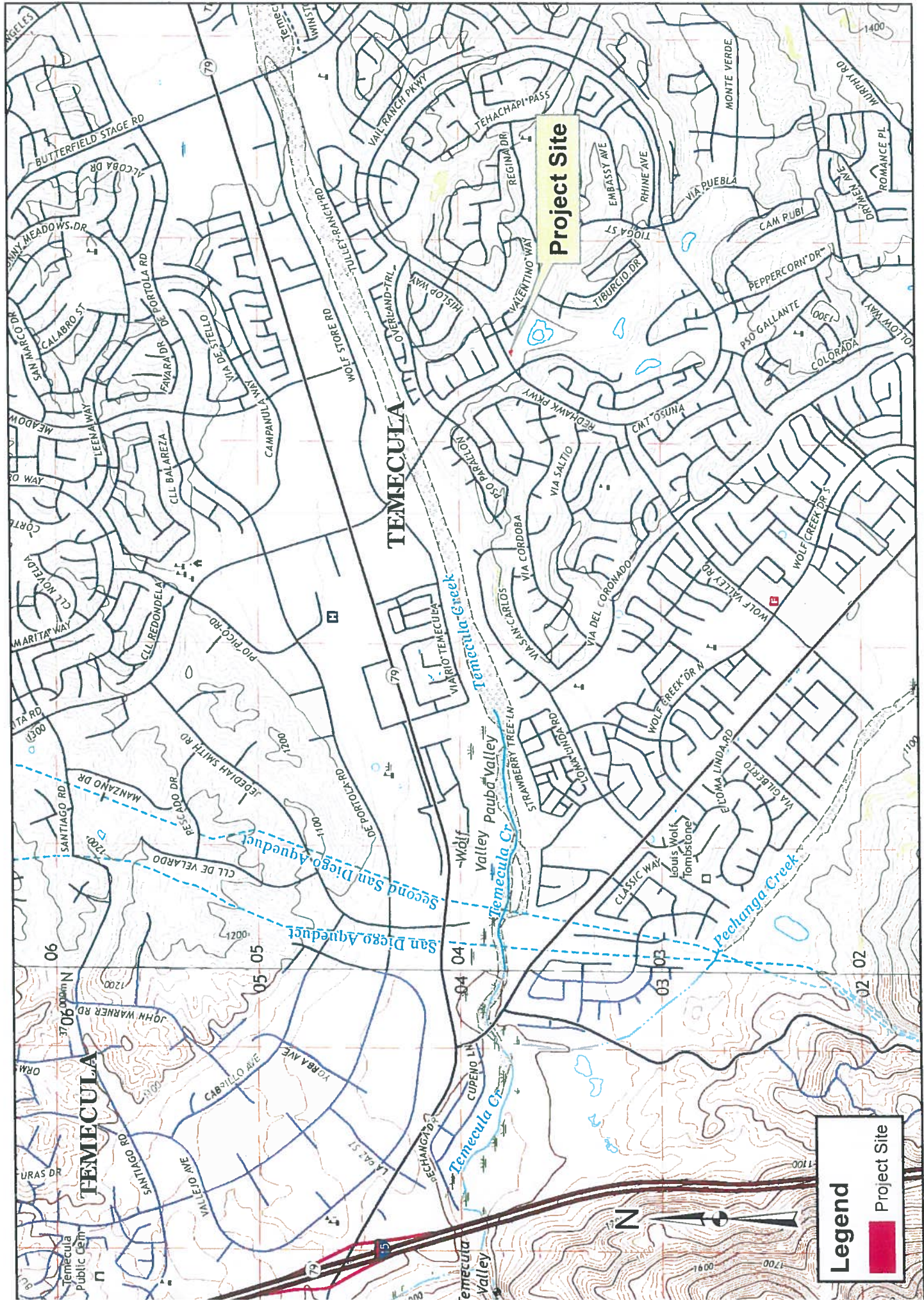
