Specific Project Location – Identify street address and cross street or attach a map showing project site (preferably a USGS 15’ or 7 ½’ topographical map identified by quadrangle name):

The reservoir project site (APN: 927-410-005, -006 and -042) is adjacent to Anza Road, approximately one half mile south of its intersection with Pauba Road in an unincorporated area of Riverside County in Section 1, Township 8 South, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian. The 5.31-acre site presently contains Anza Reservoir No. 1 and pump station and its address is 42260 Anza Road, Temecula, CA.

The soils storage/disposal site (APN: 966-080-001) is adjacent to State Highway 79 South, approximately one-half mile westerly of its intersection with Anza Road in an unincorporated area of Riverside County in Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian. The 5.7-acre parcel presently contains Well No. 141 and its address is 34275 Highway 79 South, Temecula, CA. The soils storage/disposal site is approximately two road miles from the Anza Reservoir No. 2 site. An overview map of the Project site showing existing and proposed facilities is attached.

General Project Location (City and/or County): Unincorporated Riverside County

Project Description:

The Project consists of constructing, operating, and maintaining a new three-million gallon potable water storage reservoir adjacent to RCWD’s Anza Reservoir No. 1 and pump station, including the following:


- Anza Reservoir No. 2 would be either an above-ground welded steel reservoir or pre-stressed concrete reservoir serving RCWD’s existing 1380 Pressure Zone.
- The reservoir floor elevation would be 1352 and the high water elevation would be 1382.75.
- A 24-inch concrete mortar lined and coated (CML&C) transmission main from the existing piping at the Anza Reservoir No. 1 site to the new reservoir.
- Flexible expansion joint pipe connections at the reservoir pipeline inlets/outlets and a reservoir internal mixing system.
- Associated reservoir electrical equipment and conduits, such as security lighting, telemetry, transformers on concrete equipment pads, and a sacrificial anode cathodic protection system if a welded steel tank is installed.
- Security fencing and landscaping around the reservoir perimeter.
- Site preparation consisting of clearing, grubbing, preparation of the finish grade, and applying hydromulch and other erosion control measures upon the completion of construction.
- Excavation for Anza Reservoir No. 2 would generate up to 17,000 cubic yards of material that would be trucked off-site for storage and/or disposal at RCWD’s property at Well No. 141.

The purpose of the Project is to provide potable water storage for RCWD’s 1380 Pressure Zone in order to meet projected water service demands and fire flow. The reservoir will also enable RCWD to avoid on-peak pumping of water which reduces the cost of purchasing electricity from the local electric utility company.

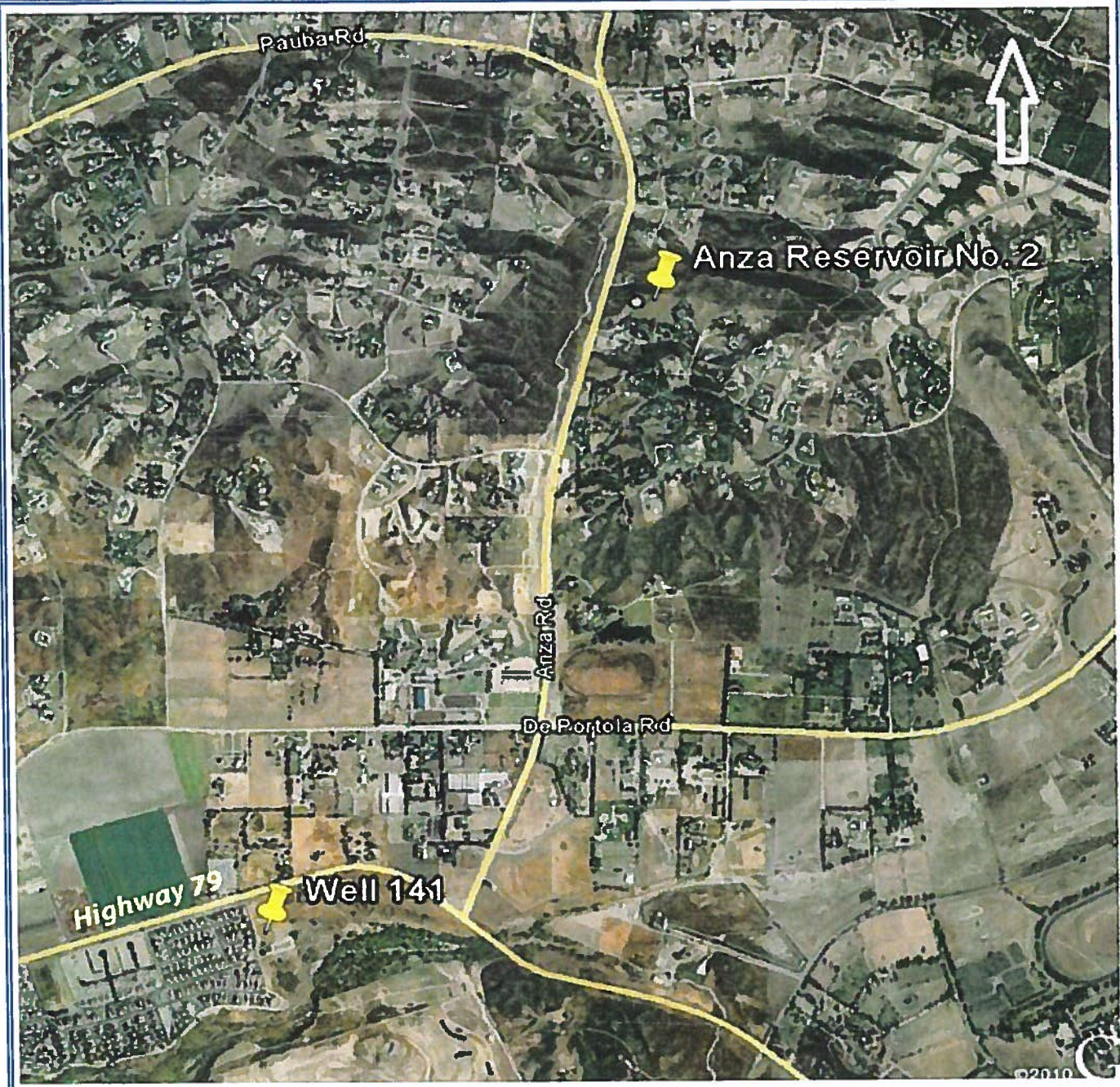
