

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-6-17**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
RANCHO CALIFORNIA WATER DISTRICT, RIVERSIDE  
COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE RANCHO  
CALIFORNIA WATER DISTRICT 2020 URBAN WATER  
MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 during the 1983-1984 Regular session of the California Legislature (Water Code Section 10610 *et seq.*), known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act of 1983 (Act), which mandates that every urban supplier of water providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually, prepare an urban water management plan, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water; and

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Senate Bill X7-7 (Water Code section 10608 *et seq.*), which requires water suppliers to develop urban water use targets for 2015 and 2020 in order to demonstrate a 20 percent reduction in per capita urban water use by 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Rancho California Water District (Rancho Water/District) has updated its Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) pursuant to the requirements of California Water Code Section 10610 *et seq.* and section 10608 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the District's 2020 UWMP has been revised to reflect the changes in law, recommend analytical protocols, variations between the 2015 and 2020 cycles, and improves the usefulness of Rancho Water's 2015 UWMP; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 2020 UWMP Update is to ensure the appropriate level of reliability in water service sufficient to meet the water needs of its various customers during normal, single-dry or multiple-dry years; and

WHEREAS, the District continues to develop and implement conservation programs and alternative water supplies that contribute toward the conservation and efficient use of water resources to ensure adequate water supplies now and in the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 UWMP Update will be periodically reviewed updated, adopted, and submitted no less than every five years on or before July 1, in the years ending in one and six, to reflect changes in water supply trends and conservation polices within the water service area of the District; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and was held by the Board of Directors of Rancho Water on June 10, 2021 to receive public comments regarding the 2020 UWMP Update; and

WHEREAS, Section 10652 of the California Water Code provides that the California Environmental Quality Act (Division 13 (commencing with Section 21000) of the Public Resources Code) (CEQA) does not apply to the preparation and adoption of the 2020 Plan pursuant to this part.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Directors of the Rancho California Water District as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Directors of the Rancho California Water District approves and adopts the 2020 Urban Water Management Plan Update for the Rancho California Water District as amended by changes resulting from input at the public hearing, if any.

Section 2. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to include a copy of this Resolution in the Rancho California Water District 2020 Plan and file a copy of the 2020 UWMP Update with the California Department of Water Resources after this date, and prior to July 1, 2021.

Section 3. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of the 2020 UWMP Update with the California State Library and any city or county within which Rancho California provides water supplies no later than thirty (30) days after this adoption date.

Section 4. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed, in accordance with Water Code section 10645, to make the 2020 Plan available for public review at the Rancho California Water District's offices during normal business hours no later than thirty (30) days after filing a copy of the Plan with California Department of Water Resources.


Section 5. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed, in accordance with Water Code Section 10635(c), to provide that portion of the 2020 Plan prepared pursuant to Water Code Section 10635(a)-(b) to any city or county within which Rancho California provides water supplies no later than sixty (60) days after submitting a copy of the Plan with DWR.

Section 6. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to implement the programs described in the 2020 UWMP Update.

Section 7. The Board of Directors finds and determines that this resolution is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Water Code Section 10652 because CEQA does not apply to the preparation and adoption, including addenda thereto, of an urban water management plan or to the implementation of the actions taken pursuant to such plans. Because this resolution comprises the Board of Director's adoption of its 2020 Plan and involves its implementation, no CEQA review is required.


