IRWM Plan Project Selection Process

How Does My Project Get Reviewed and Selected?

The project submittal process is a dynamic and on-going process to allow for new and updated projects to be readily incorporated into the IRWM Plan. Submitted projects are reviewed for inclusion in the IRWM Plan, and then prioritized. Projects that do not yet meet the IRWM Plan requirements, but through further development could potentially benefit the Region are considered conceptual projects. Although not yet in the Plan, these conceptual projects are still tracked as part of the IRWM planning process. The flowchart below shows an overview of this process.

How Do I Submit My Project?

Submittal of projects is encouraged at any time or during a Call-for-Projects. The Project Nomination Form, located on the USMW IRWM Web page, should be completed and submitted following the instructions on the form.
